

Day 1 & 2 LANSING – CHICAGO TO MADRID (Friday-Saturday) Depart Lansing for O'Hare Airport and overnight flight to Spain. Upon arrival in Madrid, transfer to our pre-tour hotel to relax and rest up for the tour starting the next morning. Inflight meals

Day 3. MADRID - ZARAGOZA – PAMPLONA (Sunday) Pick up at the hotel and depart to Zaragoza. The capital of the Province of Aragon, Zaragoza is located on the Ebro River. Famous for its stunning Pilar Basilica and architecture ranging from Mudejar to Medieval, Gothic, Baroque, Renaissance and Modernism. We continue to Pamplona, a city famous for the San Fermin festivities and its charming old quarter. B,D

Day 4. PAMPLONA – SAN SEBASTIAN – BILBAO - SANTANDER (Monday) Depart for San Sebastian towards San Sebastian, one of the most elegant cities in northern Spain. Take a stroll along La Concha Bay or enjoy the old town. Continue to Bilbao, capital of the province of Biscay, stopping briefly to admire the avant-garde Guggenheim Museum building. Dinner and overnight. B,D

Day 5. SANTANDER – SANTILLANA - COVADONGA - OVIEDO (Tuesday) Depart to Santillana del Mar, city considered as a National Monument with medieval towers and Renaissance Palace. Departure through Picos de Europa mountains through splendid landscapes. Arrival to Covadonga, set in the beautiful mountain countryside, with free time to visit the Shrine and continuation to Oviedo. B,D

Day 6. OVIEDO – LA CORUNA - SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (Wednesday) Departure towards Galicia and arrive in the stately city of La Coruna, A brief panoramic tour and continuation through the areas of Lueca, Ribadeo and Lugo in the Region of Galicia. B,D

Day 7. SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA (Thursday) City tour of this legendary pilgrimage town, world-famous Romanesque cathedral and Praça do Obradoiro, a monumental square surrounded by magnificent buildings in various styles. B,D

Day 8. SANTIAGO DE COMPOSTELA – RIAS BAJAS - VIGO (Friday) Depart for the area of the Spanish Fjords (Rias Bajas), through splendid landscapes: with a brief stop at La Toja Island. Stop at O Grove to take a tour to see an oyster and mussel farm, including a tasting of mussels and Ribeiro wine. We then continue to Vigo. B

Day 9 VIGO – VIANA DO CASTELO-BRAGA-PORTO (Saturday) Crossing the Portuguese border we arrive in Viana do Castelo, a city located between the mouth of the river Miño and Porto. Free time to visit the old town with cobbled streets and emblazoned buildings. We continue to Braga known as the city of archbishops and the third most populated city in Portugal. Free time. Departure to Porto, considered as World Heritage city Continue to Oporto. B

Day 10. PORTO (Sunday) Panoramic tour to admire the Cathedral, the Stock Exchange building, St. Clara church... we will finalize at a local wine cellar to enjoy a tasting of the famous "Port wine", the delicious wine produced from the grapes of the Duoro Valley. B,

Day 11. PORTO - COIMBRA (Monday) Depart for Coimbra, site of one of the oldest universities in Europe and birthplace of Fado, the music of Portugal. B,D

Day 12. COIMBRA – FATIMA - LISBON (Tuesday) Depart for Fatima, an important pilgrimage center, famous for the 1917 apparitions of the Virgin Mary to three shepherd children. Free time to visit the shrine before we continue to Lisbon, the capital of Portugal. B

Day 13. LISBON (Wednesday) Morning city sightseeing tour: old Alfama Quarter, Tower of Belem, Monastery of Los Jeronimos, etc. Afternoon at leisure. This evening enjoy dinner at a traditional taverna with Fado-style music. B,D

Day 14 -LISBON – MERIDA – MADRID (Thursday) Depart towards the Spanish border to arrive in Mérida. Explore its impressive archaeological complex, featuring the Roman Theatre and Amphitheatre, both declared UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Lunch at leisure. Afterwards, we continue our journey to Madrid and our hotel for the night. B

Day 15 – MADRID – CHICAGO - LANSING (Friday) This afternoon board our flight for Chicago on to Lansing. B, inflight meals
